1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to provide protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 8.
2. It has been averred that both the petitioners are major and have solemnized marriage against the wishes of the private respondents. The date of birth of petitioner No.1 is 16.12.1987 and a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate to that effect is attached as Annexure P/1 and the date of birth of petitioner No. 2 is 21.08.1989 and a copy of the Secondary School Examination Certificate is attached as Annexure P/2. The petitioners belong to different caste/community. The marriage of the petitioners was solemnised on 05.06.2015 according to Hindu rites and ceremonies and the copy of the marriage certificate is annexed as Annexure P/3 and photographs of the marriage ceremony are attached as Annexures P/4. The petitioners have made representation to respondent No.2 on 05.06.2015 (Annexure P/5) for the protection of their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

3. After hearing counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the validity of the marriage and the age of the petitioners and keeping in view the binding precedent of the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Lata Singh Vs. State of U.P. and another 2006(2) SCC (Criminal) 478*, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondents no. 2 and 3 to look into the said issue of the petitioners' representation (Annexure P/5) and take necessary action in accordance with law and provide protection, if required.
