Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in Complaint No. 28 of 2014, under Sections 324, 325, 323, 452, 148 and 149 of IPC, Police Station, Mukerian, pending in the Court of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 09.06.2015, this Court had directed the petitioner to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate and the concerned Magistrate is directed to release him on bail on furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount, as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 09.06.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the learned trial Court and has

submitted requisite bail bonds to its satisfaction and he is ready to face trial.

In view of the above, order dated 09.06.2015 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
