This petition has been moved by Jagdeep Singh under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.103 dated 28.3.2015 registered under Sections 332, 353, 307, 186 and 34 IPC at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

Counsel for the injured- Jungsher Singh has shown copy of compromise deed in which it is simply mentioned that with the intervention of the respectables of the vicinity, a compromise has been effected. There appears to be some hidden reasons because the injured is a resident of Ambala City whereas the accused are of Fatehgarh Sahib. Though the compromise at this stage is not prima-facie convincing yet it may be a sufficient ground for granting bail to the petitioner specifically when the injured/complainant has no objection. The next date before the trial Court is

stated to be 31.7.2015 for framing of charge and the Court may proceed as per law.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
