By way of this present petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., petitioner Sumitra wife of Manohar Lal has sought grant of anticipatory bail in criminal complaint No.31 dated 15.03.2014, titled 'Sunil Kumar Dalmia Vs. Sumitra Bai & another, under Sections 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, pending in the Court of JMIC Bathinda, District Bathinda, in which she has been summoned vide order dated 24.07.2014 on account of bouncing of her cheque No.593905 dated 14.01.2014 of Rs.2,00,000/- issued in favour of the complainant Sunil Kumar Dalmia.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that vide order dated 09.04.2015 passed by the trial Court, the petitioner

has been summoned through non-bailable warrant for 15.07.2015. He further contends that although the offence is bailable, but there being non-bailable warrants issued against the petitioner, there is every apprehension that she would be sent behind the bars.

Keeping in view the fact that the offence is bailable, the petitioner is directed to appear before the learned trial Court on or before 30.06.2015. On her appearance, she shall be released on bail on her furnishing bail bonds and two sound sureties to its satisfaction. In case, the petitioner would not comply with the direction given in this order, in that eventuality, this order shall stand automatically withdrawn.

The present petition is disposed of with the aforesaid observation.
