This order will dispose of CRM-M No. 19525 and CRM-M No. 19627 of 2015.

Prayer in the present petitions is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners, who are in custody since 31.10.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in the statements of PW1, PW2, PW3 and PW7, the petitioners have not been identified as accused. PW1 Rohit is the complainant, whereas PW2 Savitri is the injured. As the trial is likely to take time, the petitioners may be granted bail.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that recovery of pistol and motor cycle was made from the petitioners. Eight out of fourteen prosecution witnesses have already been examined. The trial is likely to conclude soon. The allegations against the petitioners are serious in nature.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts noticed above, where the petitioners have not been identified either by the complainant or by the injured, in my opinion, the petitioners deserve concession of bail pending trial. They are directed to be released on furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate, Rewari.

Both the petitions stand disposed of.
