Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 26, dated 29.04.2015, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Mattewal, Amritsar (Rural).

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Vide order dated 29.06.2015, this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

Learned State counsel after receiving instructions from ASI Hardeep Singh informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 29.06.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
