Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.88 dated 09.05.2015, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 420, 406 and 506 of the Indian penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

There are serious allegations against the petitioner that he along with others entered into an agreement to sell with the complainant and cheated the complainant to the tune of ₹20 lacs by way of earnest

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money. It has been shown to this Court by learned State counsel that the petitioner had received the amount and signed the receipt in this regard.

Keeping in view the gravity of offence, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.
