AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners, who are majors and assert that they have contracted a marriage against the wishes of respondents 4, 5 and 8, who are related to petitioner No.1. They apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of these respondents. Highlighting their grievance and apprehension, they have moved a representation dated 06.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.2.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 06.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar-respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 06.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if need be, take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
