AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 11.

The statement of Nafisa mother of petitioner No.1 and the statement of petitioner No.2 have been recorded. Both the parties have compromised the matter. The mother of the petitioner No.1 has stated that now her family has no problem with the marriage of the petitioners and they will cooperate with the petitioner No.2 in quashing the FIR lodged against him. The petitioner No.2 has also stated that he will also cooperate with

the family of the petitioner No.1 in quashing the FIR lodged against them.

On the request of the learned counsel, Mr. A.S. Sullar, Standing Counsel for the U.T. Chandigarh is directed to permit the petitioners to stay in the protection home for a period two weeks. He further states that in case any feeling of insecurity persists in the minds of the petitioners, the U.T. Administration will not be averse to consider further extension of stay in the protection home.

The petition is allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
