**FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.**

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.51 dated 8.3.2015 under Sections 406/420/467/471/506/120-B/34 IPC registered at Police Station Ladwa, District Kurukshetra.

It is *inter alia* contended by the learned counsel for the petitioners that earlier daughter of the petitioner namely Hardeep Kaur had filed a complaint against the present complainant Manjeet Singh and that the present FIR has been lodged by the complainant as a counter blast to the same.

Learned State counsel has sought to oppose the grant of bail to the petitioners on the grounds that there are serious allegations of fraud committed by the petitioners by taking ₹40 lacs on the pretext of sending abroad.

Appreciating these submissions apparently there

is a matrimonial dispute which had led to claims and counter-claims and, thus, there is misuse of process of the Court.

Keeping in view the same, the present petition seeking anticipatory bail is allowed. Petitioners be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer and that they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
