Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.05 dated 23.01.2015, registered at Police Station Sherpur, District Sangrur, under Sections 307, 323, 148 and 149 IPC, Section 201 IPC (added later on) and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that simple injury has been attributed to the petitioner and injured has been discharged from the hospital. The petitioner has been behind bars since 04.04.2015.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case

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and the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
