MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioners pray for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 418 dated 25.5.2015 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323,324, 326, 341, 506 IPC at Police Station City, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

It is contended by the learned counsel for the petitioners that out of the four injuries as has been mentioned in the FIR, injury no.1 is by a sharp weapon and the remaining three injuries are blunt. He further contended that these blunt injuries have been declared to be simple and only injury no.1 has been subsequently declared to be grievous. The sharp injury has been attributed to Sanjeev Kumar alias Sonu who is not an applicant.

Noticing the aforesaid facts this Court had granted interim protection to the petitioners vide its order dated 10.6.2015 subject to the compliance of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioners have since joined investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh.

Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation to the

satisfaction of the Investigating Officer, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 10.6.2015 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioners continue to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
