There is no representation for the petitioner, but, all the more, I have considered the case on merits in the following circumstances.

All the three petitions are connected, brought at the instance of the Insurance Company, against the orders permitting an amendment by substitution of the name of the driver given in the claim petitions as Jarnail Singh amended as Sukhwant Singh. In respect of the very same accident there had been other claims as well which have been brought in appeals before this Court in FAO No. 2513 of 2003

and batch of cases. This Court has held that Sukhwant Singh himself, at the time when he was apprehended on the spot, had given a false name and since this aspect had already been considered by this Court, I find no room for intervention with the orders passed by the Tribunals allowing for the amendment in the manner sought for.

All the civil revision petitions are dismissed.
