Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.30 dated 23.04.2015, under Sections 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Amritsar.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 11.06.2015:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it was a second marriage of both the parties. They lived together for a period of about two months. The FIR has been registered under Section 498-A IPC only. The allegation regarding threatening with a pistol was not found to be true on investigation by the Assistant Commissioner of Police (Homes), Amritsar. Part of the dowry articles have been

returned. The petitioner is ready and willing to return rest of the dowry articles also.

Notice of motion to Advocate General, Punjab for 17.7.2015.

In the meantime, in case of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/ Investigating Officer. He shall appear before the Investigating Officer as and when called upon for further investigation. He shall also be bound by all the conditions as contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Charna Masih has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 11.06.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
