Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 06, dated 24.04.2015, for the offences punishable under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station NRI, District SAS Nagar.

The accused/petitioner is the *Jeth* of the complainant-Sandeep Kaur. He was the negotiator of the marriage of the complainant with her NRI husband, who is alleged to have abandoned her.

The parties have resolved their entire dispute and executed a written compromise deed dated 24.12.2015, a photocopy of the same has been taken on record as **Mark-A**.

In compliance of the terms of the deed, a sum of Rs. 2 lacs by way of demand draft has been paid to the complainant-Sandeep Kaur and the remaining amount of Rs. 9 lacs shall be paid as per schedule in the said deed.

Learned counsel for the complainant, in light of the compromise deed, has no objection if the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner is made absolute.

In view of the above, the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.07.2015 is made absolute.

The parties shall be bound by their respective statements.
