Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Section 406 of the IPC, in a case arising out of FIR No.250 dated 28.05.2002, registered at Police Station Sunam District Sangrur (Annexure P/1).

After registration of the FIR, the challan was presented and the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court. After grant of bail, he remained absent from the Court and on 06.08.2007 and on 10.03.2009 he was declared proclaimed offender by the trial Court. The petitioner has been suffering from HCV +ve and diabetic type-II and taking regular treatment from various hospitals including Lilawati Hospital since 2006 as per Annexure P-3. After declaration of proclaimed offender, he surrendered on 21.12.2014.

On notice, reply has been filed by the Deputy Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur and a per the medical

report (Annexure R-1), the petitioner has been diagnosed as a known case of diabetes mellitus-2 and HCV+ve. For such kind of cases, they refer the patients to Rajindra Hospital, Patiala and PGI, Chandigarh. As per the report (Annexure R-1), the petitioner cannot be given adequate treatment in the jail.

Keeping in view that the petitioner was regularly appearing before the trial Court from 2002 to 2007, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail, subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sangrur.
