Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.26 dated 11.4.2015 under Sections 452, 323, 148/149/325/326/379 IPC (Section 325 has been wrongly typed/repeated in the petition instead of Section 326 IPC, as stated by learned counsel for the petitioners) registered at Police Station Arni Wala, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition *qua* Atma Ram, petitioner no.1.

Prayer is accepted and this petition is dismissed as withdrawn *qua* Atma Ram, petitioner no.1.

This Court vide order dated 11.6.2015 had granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to their joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to order dated 11.6.2015, the petitioners No.2 to 6 have joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurtej Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 11.6.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute *qua* petitioners no.2 to 6. However, the petitioners no.2 to 6 shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
