This is a petition for quashing of criminal proceedings on the basis of compromise. Petitioners have been acquitted of offence under Section 326 IPC, but have been convicted under Section 323/324 IPC, with the aid of Section 34, IPC.

Statements of the parties have been recorded, regarding the matter having been compromised.

In view of the said circumstances, this petition is disposed of with an observation that the Appellate Court, on the basis of the compromise having been arrived at between the parties, would be entitled to give benefit of doubt to the petitioners in appeal and

acquit them or consider the compromise as mitigating circumstance to grant any other relief, i.e. to grant the concession of probation.
