Through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C the petitioner seeks a direction to respondent No.1-State to protect the life and liberty of the family of the petitioner and take action against respondents No. 2 to 5.

It appears that civil litigation is pending between the petitioner and the private respondents.

In view of the fact that the petitioner and his son or any of his family members are not required to be arrested at the instance of private respondents, by the local police, no direction is required to be passed in the case.

This petition is disposed of as having rendered infructuous without prejudice to the other rights of the petitioner.
