Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.14 dated 05.02.2015, registered under Sections 148/149/323/307/120-B/452 (added later on) of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act, at Police Station Jagadhri Sadar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

In pursuance of order dated 18.06.2015, status report by way of affidavit of Sub Inspector Birkha Ram, SHO, Sadar Jagadhari has

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been filed in Court today which is taken on record.

Vide order dated 18.06.2015, a Coordinate Bench of this Court directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer in connection with above-said case FIR.

On instructions from SI Birkha Ram, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Learned State counsel further states that nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, order dated 18.06.2015 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute.

Present petition is disposed of accordingly.
