The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 15, dated 7.3.2009, registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 506, 148, 149, 341 of the IPC, at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Rupnagar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody for almost six months, and that all other co-accused have been acquitted but the petitioner had absented himself and that is why he was incarcerated.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, has accepted these factual assertions.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case and keeping in

view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Rupnagar. Petition stands disposed of.
