The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.232 dated 15.05.2015, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, Police Station Punhana, District Mewat.

The facts are that a case under the Cow Slaughter Act was registered at Police Station Punhana on 26.02.2015. The allegations are that the petitioner came to the police station and produced Sahid @ Pappu who had been nominated in the FIR. The said person was joined in the investigation and his signatures were obtained on the arrest memo and identity card and the person arrested was produced before the Court and was sent to judicial custody. Few days later when the accused appended his signatures on power of attorney and filed his bail application, it came to the notice of the police that the person was not Sahid but was Pappu son of Almuddin Kureshi, resident of the same village, who had added Sahid before his name but name of his father was different. The fraud came to the

notice of the police officials and the FIR was registered. The police now wants to arrest the petitioner.

The main contention of the petitioner is that he has been falsely implicated and the police had arrested a wrong person and is now blaming the petitioner and he was ready to join the investigation.

There are allegations of fraud and cheating. The petitioner had produced Pappu son of Almuddin in place of Sahid son of Alijan who was wanted in FIR No.55/2015, registered under the Cow Slaughter Act. The petitioner has tried to mislead the police and got another man arrested. The petitioner is not entitled to anticipatory bail. The petition is dismissed.
