AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners allege threat to their life and liberty from respondents 4 to 7 as they have married against their wishes. Petitioners, highlighting this aspect, have approached the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar-respondent No.2 by way of a representation dated 09.06.2015 (Annexure P-5).

Counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners at this stage would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 09.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar-respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioners dated 09.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if need be, take appropriate steps in accordance with law.
