This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.105 dated 05.07.2013, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Bhogpur, Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Heard.

Vide order dated 23.09.2014, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court, for getting their statements

recorded. In compliance thereof, report of JMIC, dated 08.01.2015 has been received, wherein, it has been noticed that the parties have compromised the matter with their free consent, sweet will, without any threat, pressure or undue influence.

In view of the above and the law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**', **2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab, 2014 (6) SCC, 466**, this Court feels that no purpose would be served in keeping the proceedings alive.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.105 dated 05.07.2013, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Bhogpur, Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner(s).
