AJAY TEWARI, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 39 dated 09.05.2015 under section 306 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Dina Nagar, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 12.06.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned Additional Advocate General, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh, has accepted the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and that he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts and circumstances of the case and without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 12.06.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous, if any, also stands disposed of.
