This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.85 dated 18.05.2003, registered under Sections 324, 323 r/w Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur and the judgment dated 20.09.2012, passed by the Court of JMIC, Ferozepur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Heard.

Vide order dated 27.08.2014, the parties were directed to appear before the learned Appellate Court, for getting their statements recorded. In compliance thereof, report of Addl. Sessions Judge, dated 22.09.2014 has been received, wherein, it has been noticed that the compromise arrived at between the parties is genuine.

In view of the above and the law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**', **2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab, 2014 (6) SCC, 466**, this Court feels that no purpose would be served in keeping the proceedings alive.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.85 dated 18.05.2003, registered under Sections 324, 323 r/w Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Mamdot, District Ferozepur and the judgment dated 20.09.2012, passed by the Court of JMIC, Ferozepur and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner(s).
