AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed in case bearing FIR No. 39 dated 31.03.2013, under Section 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel states that the petitioner was facing trial in a case involving non-commercial quantity of intoxicating powder and had been granted regular bail. By mistake he noted the date as 27.05.2015 instead of 07.05.2015 and did not appear in the Court. Otherwise he is not facing any other case.

Learned Addl.AG, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Singh, has accepted the fact that the petitioner has never misused the concession of bail and is not facing any other case.

Keeping in view this fact I do not deem it appropriate to deny

the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner appear before the trial Court on the date fixed and the trial Court shall release him on anticipatory bail to its satisfaction.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
