The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 568, dated 30.12.2014, registered under Sections 324/307 read with Section 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonapat.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he caught hold of the injured.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody for almost six months and that the injured has already been discharged from hospital.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from ASI Satbir Singh, has not denied the factual assertions.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping

in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat. Petition stands disposed of.
