Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.109 dated 17.7.2014 under Sections 302, 34 IPC and Section 506 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

In view of order passed today in **CRM No.M-18908 of 2015 Khushwinder Singh v. State of Punjab & anr.**, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the trial Court within a week from today and the trial Court shall admit him on bail, subject to his furnishing of bail bonds/surety

bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
