Two accused have prayed for quashing of the FIR No. 132, dated 03.09.2011, under Sections 420, 354, 292(2), 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

As per the reply, filed by Raj Kumar Jalhotra, DSP, Abohar, District Fazilka, on completion of investigation, the challan was presented and charges have been framed. Thereafter, till the date of filing the affidavit on 18.03.2013, three out of the total five prosecution witnesses stood examined.

None is present at the time of hearing on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Jaskaran Singh, states that in the light of charges framed, no case for quashing the said FIR is made out.

This Court finds some merits in the arguments on behalf of the learned State Counsel. Moreover, it appears that the entire evidence by now would have been led and even the trial concluded since no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioners after 21.11.2014.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed for want of prosecution.
