Prayer made in the instant petition is for seeking permission to travel abroad from 21.07.2015 to 31.07.2015.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel assisted by Mr. J.S. Ghuman, Advocate for the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner seeks to travel abroad with the permission of the Court from

21.07.2015 to 31.07.2015. He further submits that petitioner has made all the arrangements of his travel programme.

The learned trial Court has declined the above prayer vide order dated 29.04.2015 (Annexure P-1).

In CRM No.M-8431 of 2014 the trial Court has been directed to adjourn the hearing beyond the date fixed by this Court. CRM No.M-8431 of 2014 is fixed for 20.07.2015. Even the date fixed before the trial Court is 01.08.2015. A similar prayer made by the co-accused in CRM No.M-4558 of 2015 was allowed by this Court on 18.03.2015 by imposing certain conditions.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed, permitting the petitioner to travel abroad from 21.07.2015 to 30.07.2015, so that he attends the trial Court on 01.08.2015 the date already fixed before the trial Court. It is further directed that petitioner will furnish a surety and also file original title/sale deed of some immovable property in the trial Court in terms of the order dated 18.03.2015 passed in CRM No.M-4558 of 2015.
