Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeks quashing of FIR No.149 dated 14.06.2011 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Rajpura City, District Patiala.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply has been filed.

Learned counsel for the State submits that not only the charge has been framed but the trial has also commenced. One PW has already been examined and the next date of hearing before the learned trial Court is 27.08.2015. She further submits that in this view of the matter, present petition does not survive and the same may be disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of the Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to raise all possible pleas available to him before the learned trial, during the course of trial.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as prayed for.
