Petitioners have approached this Court apprehending danger to their life and liberty from respondents No. 4 to 7 as they have got married on 10.06.2015 against their wishes.

Respondent No. 5-Khadiza Parveen wife of Mohammad Salim has put in appearance in person along with her counsel. She states that from now onwards, none of these respondents i.e. respondents No. 4 to 7 will have any relation whatsoever with the petitioners. For them, they are no one. She further states that they would not interfere in the life and liberty of the petitioners and would not be responsible, in case they are unable to live together or anything happens to the girl i.e. petitioner No. 1, namely, Aliya

Chaudhary.

In the light of the statement made by respondent No. 5 in Court today and also keeping in view the fact that the petitioners apprehending danger to their life and liberty have filed a representation dated 10.06.2015 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur-respondent No. 2 as also to the Station House Officer, City Police Station Malerkotla-respondent No. 3 to look into the said representation and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law, including providing protection to the petitioners' life and liberty, if required.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
