Instant petition has been preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 14 dated March 27, 2015 under Sections 323, 324, 326, 379-B, 356, 341, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Talwandi Chaudhrian, District Kapurthala.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

4. Concededly allegation against the petitioner is that he accompanied by Sandeep Singh @ Seepa and Major Singh caused injuries to injured/complainant by breaking bottles striking with electric pole but there is no corresponding injury as per the contents of MLRs. The broken bottles have already been recovered.

5. So, without commenting on the merits of the case, instant petition stands accepted. Petitioner is order to be released on interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Officer subject to following conditions, as envisaged in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

1. That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
