Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.01 dated 03.01.2015 under Sections 427, 379, 447, 336, 506, 511, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar.

This Court, vide order dated 15.06.2015, has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to the compliance of provisions of Section 438(2) CrPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that pursuant to the order dated 15.06.2015, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Sub Inspector, Gurmit Singh, submits that though the petitioners have joined the investigation but they are not cooperating in the manner which is required for proper investigation.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the allegations against the petitioners are regarding theft of four bags of urea (fertiliser). Petitioners are claiming to be a lessee over the Panchayat land. Since the urea fertiliser is perishable item, recovery of such bags may not be possible.

After taking into consideration the nature of dispute and considering allegations, the instant petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 15.06.2015, is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
