This is the second application for the grant of pre-arrest bail on the ground that the petitioners are still ready and willing to amicably resolve the money dispute with the complainant Durgesh Dalia. When earlier application was dismissed on 4.3.2014 it was observed that in case the matter is amicably resolved, it will be open to the petitioners to approach this Court again.

A perusal of the second petition filed by the petitioners does not indicate that any steps for reconciliation have been taken or that the petitioners have been able to discharge their liability by payment of any amount to the complainant.

The second petition is disposed of as not maintainable. However, it will be open to the petitioners to file a fresh petition in case the matter is amicably resolved finally between the parties.
