Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.104 dated 04.04.2015, under Sections 15, 16, 27-A of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985 ('Act' for short), registered at Police Station City Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Following order was passed by this Court on 09.07.2015:-

“Adjourned to 1.9.2015.

In the meantime, arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed subject to his joining the investigation and also complying with the following conditions:

- i) that he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;*
- ii) that he shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*

iii) that he shall not leave India without the prior permission to the Court.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Ram Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation. On a query put by this Court, learned State counsel has further submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case under the Act.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 09.07.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
