The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.89, dated 27.5.2014, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC, at Police Station Jhabhal, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that only simple injury is attributed to the petitioner and that the person to whom injury under Section 326 of the IPC is attributed was arrested and has been released on bail.

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from SI Harnek Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, this petition

is allowed and it is directed that in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer to his satisfaction subject to the compliance of the provisions as contained in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
