AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel contends that petitioners are majors and have got married on 11.06.2015 without the consent of respondents No.5 to 7. Respondents 5 and 6 are the parents of petitioner No.1 and respondent No.7 is her brother. Respondents No.5 to 7 are against the marriage of the petitioners. Petitioners, apprehending danger to the life and liberty, have approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 10.06.2015 (Annexure P-3) praying for the grant of protection of their life and liberty.

Counsel contends that the petitioners, at this stage, would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.2 to consider and take appropriate action on their representation dated 10.06.2015 (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioners, without going into merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with directions to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala-respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 10.06.2015 (Annexure P-3) and if need be, take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
