HARI PAL VERMA, J.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner- Davinder Singh son of Rashpal Singh, resident of Vill. Pandori Waraich, Tehsil and District Amritsar, who has been booked for having committed offence punishable under Section 354/506 IPC in a case arising out of FIR No.112 dated 29.6.2014 registered at Police Station Kamboj, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 21.1.2015, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) CrPC.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sawinder Singh, Police Station Kamboj, has very fairly conceded that in compliance of interim order dated 21.1.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, in the present case, at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 21.1.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) CrPC.
