The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 3 to take action against respondent nos.4 & 5.

Heard.

Respondent no.4 had approached this Court for anticipatory bail which was allowed on 27.04.2015. Since both the parties were living in the same society but in different blocks, they were directed not to enter the block of other side so that there would be peace and no further altercation. It is contended on behalf of the petitioner that respondent no.4 has started harassing the petitioner and passed lewd remarks and was abusive on the telephone and she had managed to record one of the calls.

The petition does not contain any details and is vague. A written complaint has already been given to the police. No directions are required to be given.

The petition is dismissed.
