This petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.252 dated 07.11.2014 registered at Police Station Patran, District Patiala for offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 IPC.

Heard.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

As per the case of the prosecution, the complainant Lachhman Dass has alleged in his complaint to the police that one Harwinder Singh had taken ₹2,00,000/- from him to arrange a job for him in HDFC bank, Chandigarh. During the investigation Harwinder Singh has disclosed that the amount of ₹2,00,000/- taken from the complaint was given to the petitioner who had to arrange a job for the complainant in HDFC bank.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had neither any affinity with complainant nor the complaint had been parted with any amount on the asking or representation of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the above and the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the matter is being investigated, but without commenting anything on merit of the case, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 18.06.2015 is made absolute, on the terms mentioned therein, till the presentation of challan.
