The allegation in the FIR against the petitioner relate to an agreement to sell executed between the petitioner and the complainant. It is alleged that the complainant had paid some amount to the petitioner and his wife but the sale deed was not executed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as complainant states that the parties have arrived at compromise whereby the petitioner will pay the entire amount received by him to the complainant within six months.

Keeping in view the facts as stated above, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned CJM/Duty Magistrate Sangrur.

However, the complainant is at liberty to move application for cancellation of bail if the amount is not paid.

Disposed of accordingly.
