This order shall dispose of CRM-M-19944-2015 and CRM-M-19945-2015, as both the petitions originates from the common FIR and similar allegations have been levelled against both the petitioners.

Prayer in these petitions filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of bail to the petitioners namely Mohamad Shuaib @ Vicky son of Amir Ahmad and Vicky Kumar son of Bhandari Lal in case FIR No.147 dated 15.12.2014 under Sections 458, 34 IPC registered at P.S. Div. No.1, District Ludhiana.

There are serious allegations against the petitioners, as during investigation, recovery of huge amount has been effected from them, which was taken away by them from the house of the complainant at the time of commission of offence. There is further allegations against them that they entered the house of a lady and caused grievous injury on vital part of her body and they have also taken away huge amount and gold ornaments.

In view of the aforesaid, I find no merit in the present petitions and the same are dismissed.

However, it is made clear that the observations made here-in-above shall not be construed as any expression on the merits of the case.
