This petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.43 dated 08.04.2015 registered at Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga for offences punishable under Section 420 IPC.

Heard.

The FIR in this case has been registered on the complaint of Major Singh son of Peshawar Singh, wherein he has alleged that he had a deal with the accused named in the FIR which include the petitioner and her son. The deal for sending the complainant and his family to America, was settled for ₹21,00,000/-, out of which ₹13,00,000/- were paid but the complainant and his family was not sent abroad. Later on the passport of the complainant and his family members along with ₹4,00,000/- were returned and the amount of ₹9,00,000/- was not returned despite repeated requests.

The son of the petitioner namely Deepak Sharma is already in custody. The petitioner has also joined the investigation. The investigating agency is ascertaining the role of the accused.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a household lady having no concern with the business of his son.

Keeping in view the above facts and submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, but without commenting anything on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 17.06.2015 is made absolute, on the terms mentioned therein, till the presentation of challan.
