This is the second petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail, the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 20.3.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that Manjinder Singh @ Suba, co-accused of the petitioner, against whom same and similar allegations were there, has already been granted the concession of bail by this Court vide order dated 17.7.2014. However, he could not dispute the fact that said Manjinder Singh @ Suba was not involved in any other case, whereas the petitioner is involved in five more criminal cases, details of which were mentioned by this Court in the order dated 30.1.2015.

In view of the above, no case is made out for the grant of regular bail.

The petition is, therefore, dismissed.
