This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C read with Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for release of the petitioner on anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 205 dated 30.10.2011, registered under Sections 323, 354 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Kapurthala City.

It was stated by the petitioner that the matter relates to the incident of the year 2011 that has been actually compromised and it was believed that the police had also given the cancellation report. It appears to have been kept pending and the only act attributed to the petitioner was that he twisted the fingers of the complainant with the intention to cause bodily injury.

Noticing the aforesaid, this Court had granted interim bail to the petitioner on 17.06.2015 pursuant to which the petitioner has joined the investigation, which fact has not been controverted by the learned counsel appearing for the respondent/State, on instructions from HC Balkar Singh.

Having regard to the aforesaid, the interim directions dated 17.06.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
