The petitioner is praying for his release on bail during the pendency of the trial of the case.

The petitioner stands booked for committing offences punishable under Sections 454, 380 and 427 IPC. All these offences are triable by the Court of Judicial Magistrate.

The petitioner is in custody since 20.5.2015. Admittedly, after the arrest of the petitioner, the police did not seek his police remand.

Without commenting on the merits, lest it may prejudice the case of either party, this Court is of the considered view that the petitioner deserves the concession of bail.

Resultantly, the petition is accepted. Bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri.
