This order will dispose of three bail petitions

(1) CRM-M-19974 of 2015 filed by Jaswinder Singh @ Jajji, (2) CRM-M-20293 of 2015 filed by Ajay Pal Singh and (3) CRM-M-25907 of 2015 filed by Khushpreet Singh in a case which was registered at the instance of Sanjeev Kumar Jindal alleging that the petitioners constituted an unlawful assembly and had accompanied Sonu to cause injury on the person of complainant as well as his brother. Sonu and others had assaulted the complainant armed with kirpan and sticks. So far as the petitioners are concerned, they are not named in the FIR but involved in the case on the basis of supplementary statements of the complainant, CCTV footage indicating that the petitioners arrived on the spot on motorcycle. Ajaypal Singh was seen carrying baseball bat whereas Khushpreet Singh was allegedly armed with kirpan. Though Ajay Pal Singh is carrying baseball bat but no specific injury has been attributed to him. Co-accused of the petitioners have been granted the concession of regular bail.

Counsel for the complainant has opposed the applications stating that there are serious allegations against the petitioners and they are specifically named in the FIR.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the complainant and learned State counsel. Without expression of any opinion on merits and for the reasons mentioned herein above, all three bail applications of the petitioners are allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the CJM, Ludhiana.
