The petitioner has prayed for pre arrest bail in a case FIR No. 418 dated 25.5.2015, registered under Sections 148,149, 323,324,326,341 and 506 of the IPC at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

The FIR was registered on the statement of Brij Mohan son of Jai Gopal, who has alleged that the petitioner pushed him down from his motor cycle and has inflicted sword blows on his head which he had tried to avoid by using his hand and suffered injuries on his left hand. Injury No.1 was caused by sharp weapon and had been found to be a fracture on account of which Section 326 of the IPC was added.

Although, learned counsel for the petitioner has vehemently argued that injury is very small and on the back side but the injuries are found to have been caused with sharp edged weapon and have been found to be a fracture, therefore, the petitioner cannot be granted bail.

Dismissed.
